The home is nestled on a gently sloping hill facing the 11,000' peaks of the 3,300,000-acre Gila Wilderness in Southwestern New

Mexico. The view from the front porches of this home extend all the way into Arizona, 50 miles away. There is not another man-made structure in sight. Sitting on the main house or guest porches, you will feel as though you are in a tree house floating over the forest beyond. At an elevation of over 6,000' the summers are very mild and because we are located in the southwest, the winters are comfortable and sunny. Hard to beat the natural setting of mountains, deep canyons and the forests of juniper, pine and oak. Square-cut, hand-hewn log and heavy timber framing. The main house exterior and some interior walls were hand-built in Montana, disassembled, shipped to New Mexico and reassembled on site.

Native-stone walls, grand-entry stairs, three stone fireplaces, flagstone walks, earthy log walls, rustic roofs, massive lodge-pole columns, expensive cedar windows, cedar porch decking and hand-hewn rail-

ings all add up to a quiet harmony with the juniper and pine mountain forest of the New Mexico southwest. Quality craftsmanship and details in this home were made for loving families for generations to come.
